

## Working as an artist in the 21st century

**D**igital artist, Wayne Charles Roth is part of the changing landscape in the art-world. His work represents the blurring of the traditional art world boundaries, substituting technology and new materials in place of paint, brushes and canvas.

Trained as a classical painter, Wayne has an MFA from Rochester Institute of Technology. His interest in a new form of expression came about in the 90's, when computers and technology became part of our everyday lives. He felt that this technology allowed him to create art that was a truer reflection of the times.

The differences between creating an oil painting and a digital painting are not that great according to the artist. With digital work there is still a lot of drawing involved - just using a stylus instead of a pencil. When painting with oils he used a lot of glazes to build up depth and color and with today's software he still uses the same slow process where multiple layers of color are built up to achieve depth and power. Wayne has just released a new art series that continues his exploration of time and technology in today's world - "Crystal Dreams." This new series took over a year to develop and produce and is a softer point of view. Using more white space, the artist wants to achieve a more delicate emotional statement while striving to retain some of the complex elements from his earlier pieces. The finished art is produced using a unique ultraviolet printing process that infuses the image into the substrate

Wayne's art has been added to many private collections and he exhibits in the United States and Europe on a regular basis. He recently completed a commission for an art collector in the UK and is preparing for an exhibit in early 2019. He has also created "art" pianos and "art" furniture for select clients. He is represented by two Galleries and an art dealer.

He wants his work to appeal to viewers on different levels, from sophisticated art collectors to plain art lovers. His objective is to create compelling and unique work, and he wants his viewers to be surprised and dazzled by what they are experiencing.
